India

Prime Minister Modi attends G7 Summit:

At the personal invitation of French President Emmanuel Macron. Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi attended the G7 Summit which was held in Biarritz, France from 24 to 26 August. At the Summit, PM Modi addressed sessions on environment, climate, oceans and digital transformation, and highlighted India's large-scale efforts towards eliminating single use plastics, conserving water, harnessing solar energy and protecting flora and fauna for a sustainable future. PM Modi also held bilateral meetings on the sidelines of the Summit with leaders such as US President Donald Trump, at which trade, security and other issues of current interest were discussed.

PM Modi visits Bhutan:

He also highlighted that the intelligence and foresight of the Kings of Bhutan had guided the bilateral relations for a long time, and underlined that it was a privilege for India to be a major partner in the development of Bhutan.

PM Modi visits Bahrain: Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi visited Bahrain from 24 to 25 August, and was warmly received by the Prime Minister of Bahrain, His

Highness Prince Khalifa Bin Salman Al Khalifa. This was the first ever visit by an Indian prime minister to Bahrain. PM Modi stated that the visit was historical and would improve bilateral ties.

Indian States / Festivals

Haryana:

Haryana is located in northern India and surrounds the national capital city, New

Delhi, from three sides. The state economy ranks 13th among India's 33 states and union territories with an estimated GDP of USD 110 billion in 2019-2020 and the state's GDP growth rate is estimated at 11% from 2018-19 to 2019-20. Haryana is a well-developed industrial state with good transportation connections to surrounding states and the rest of India. It is one of India's largest automobile hubs, and accounts for about two thirds of passenger 50% of tractors and 60% of motorcycles manufactured in India. Regarding other industries, Haryana has emerged as a base for the knowledge including the industry, IT and biotechnology sectors, and is the third largest exporter of software among Indian states. For example, the city of Gurgaon, Haryana has emerged as a preferred destination for the IT industry in North India, with more than 400 IT and IT enabled Services (ITeS) companies. Some of the initiatives adopted by the Haryana Government to promote Haryana as an investment destination include development of a number of industrial estates, industrial model townships and specialized parks for cluster development, development of infrastructure facilities.

The Surajkund International Crafts Mela is held in Surajkund, Faridabad, Haryana in

February each year. The event is organized by the Surajkund Mela Authority & Haryana Tourism in collaboration with Union Ministries of Tourism, Textiles. Culture and External Affairs, and attracts more than a million visitors every year, thousands of which are foreign tourists. The Surajkund Mela is unique as it showcases the richness and diversity of the handicrafts, handlooms and cultural fabric of India, and is the largest crafts fair in the world. Other tourist attractions in Haryana include the popular pilgrim destination Kurukshetra, the ancient city of Ambala, the monuments in Hisar, the Karnal Fort and the town of Pinjore, which is home to a beautiful 17th century garden.

International commercial & business activities in India

India-France to jointly build and run space-based ship tracking system: On 26 August, the India Brand Equity Foundation reported that the world's first space-based Automatic Identification System to monitor merchant ships on real-time basis would be built and operated mutually by India and France. Dr. K Sivan, Chairman, India Space Research Organization (ISRO) and Mr. Jean-Yves Le Gall, President of the French space agency National Centre for Space Studies (CNES) recently signed an agreement to start development and production of a constellation of satellites carrying telecommunication (AIS), radar and optical remote-detecting instruments.

15th India Innovation Summit 2019:

The 15th India Innovation Summit 2019 was organized by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) in Bengaluru from 21 to 22 August. The Summit was held under the theme "Innovation Manifesto Scaling for the next decade", and included event highlights such as keynote panels by innovation promoters, master classes for hands-on experience on innovation, experience zones for the showcase of innovation across sectors and a student challenge to felicitate young entrepreneurs. Speaking at the Summit, Dr. Omkar Rai, Director General, Software Technology Park of India (STPI) stated that the goal was to take India's software industry to reach USD 80-90 billion by 2025, up from USD 8.1 billion today.

India-Norway:

India-Norway JWG on Fisheries: The 6th meeting of the Joint Working Group on cooperation on Fisheries between India and Norway was held on August 22, 2019 in Trondheim, Norway. Indian delegation was led by Secretary (Fisheries), Ms. Rajni Sekhri Sibal and the Norwegian side was led by Deputy Secretary General, Dr. Morten Berg, Ministry of Trade, Industry and Fisheries. Government of Norway. Both sides discussed issues related to cooperation in the field of aquaculture and fisheries. The Indian delegation also attended the Aqua Nor 2019 Exhibition held in Trondheim from August 20-23, 2019.
